Own Boat Tuition is delivered in your familiar environment aboard your own power vessel where your training can either;

- Be totally customised to your specific areas of interest such as manoeuvring, anchoring, berthing, launching, retrieving, safety drills or rough water handling.
- Follow a prescribed RYA curriculum and provide the opportunity to gain a globally recognised RYA qualification.

Own Boat Tuition is a fantastic and effective option as;

- It's on your vessel and at your regular marina berth or boat ramp. Therefore the content is 100% relevant to you and those that crew and enjoy the boat with you. Because of this and the small number of students, it's amazing how much can be covered in relatively little time.
- Our professional instructors not only know the subject, they also know how to teach it. This is a huge difference from experienced friends or family attempting to "show you the ropes".
- The course is delivered at a time that suits you.
- You and your crew (recommended maximum of 3 + tutor on board) can learn the exactly same thing at the same time - no more 'debates' about how things should be done!
- You can receive guidance and assistance with vessel setup and safety equipment. With many of our instructors having been heavily involved with Coastguard's Search and Rescue services, they are ideally placed to help you ensure your safety.
- Your instructor will strive to create a fun and stress free environment to ensure everyone not only learns but also enjoys the day and gets the most out of it.



How does it work?

Simply get in touch with our friendly education team. We'll have a chat about your desired outcomes, experience levels and vessel. From there we'll arrange a date that works best for you and payment for the minimum number of tuition hours will secure your booking.

A checklist will then be sent out to you to capture key information about your vessel and equipment on board to be completed and returned to our Education team.

On the day your friendly instructor will meet you at the agreed time and location and start with a quick chat to get to know each other and confirm your objectives before getting underway. Should you wish to continue beyond the minimum number of hours, generally speaking that isn't a problem as we simply settle up payment for the additional hours the next day.
